## **COMFORT TIPS**

Some quick tips with regards to the our VIBE jams:

- 1. Please bring your own <u>device</u>, or <u>print</u> to view the score (*printing or viewing via tablet is recommended*)
- 2. It is a shoes-off studio 6
- 3. Green message from the studio owner (wherever possible):
  - a) Conserve by bringing your own water bottles (reduce plastic usage  $\stackrel{f u}{=}$ ).
  - b) Consider using our recycled aircon water for flushing (though flush is available)

## VIBE HEADS-UP

- 1. Since this is a **recreational group**, we aim to create an **inclusive**, **welcoming**, and supportive environment for everyone Make fun and make friends!
- 2. Please do take some time to **go through the parts before coming** so that we may expedite the teaching process and have **more time for fun singing** (you don't have to feel 'perfect' before coming though (9))
- 3. For the people who find 简谱 easier, we got you! But please check back a couple of days after the song's usual training contents are released because 简谱 takes a much longer time to create.
- 4. As our choir is currently in the recruitment and repertoire building stage, we will jam one song per session (2 hours). This arrangement allows our members to work on ear training from song to song, and also allows us to build sufficient repertoire for future external performances (requires sufficient repertoire).
- 5. We aim to release the training materials (scores & audios) for the jam at least 7 days before the date of the jam.

If you have **no prior choir experience**, *fret not*! The learning materials and audio may feel a little new to you right now, but do note that you are totally not expected to be extremely familiar with the parts.

This is really just for everyone to know the song better (just in case you haven't even heard of the song), and to dip your feet into the song / part prior to the actual session. Please listen to the audio of your preferred part, and there will be teaching time for each part on the actual day. And yes, please sing the lyrics (including the doo doo dat / ooooo etc ) directly under the music notes of your part:)

Most traditional choirs only accept people who can sight-read, and our current method of sending these audio guides is a way for us to close the gap so that more people can enjoy choir-style singing.

- If you are a **female** please sing along to either the **Soprano / Alto** audios, and choose the one that you feel more comfortable to sing.
- If you are a male please sing along to either the Baritone audios!
- If you would like to sing **the lead** during the session, please do take the time to master the melody for the lead (as everyone else will count on your fluency and confidence as the lead! (a)
